I watched a video about the sentinels who guard the "Tomb of the Unknown Soldier" and started to do some reading about them. I was extremely impressed with the information I found on their dedication to guarding the tomb. They march for 30 minutes at a time working in 24-hour shifts and when they aren't walking the mat, they are living in the quarters beneath it. During that time, they complete training and prepare their uniforms, which can take up to eight hours. Duties remain uninterrupted during all weathers. During heat waves, blizzards, hurricanes, rain, sleet, snow, and hail they continue their guard. There is some dispute on this but there has been continuous service since July 2, 1937. The duty at the Tomb is not for everyone, with the majority of soldiers who begin Tomb Guard training being unable to meet the standards. Each soldier must have strong military bearing, discipline, stamina and present an outstanding soldierly appearance. Each Sentinel must be able to flawlessly perform seven different types of walks, honors, and ceremonies. They must retain vast amounts of knowledge concerning the Tomb, Arlington National Cemetery, the United States Army, and their unit. The honor of Tomb Guard is incredibly rare. The badge is the least awarded in the Army.

There is more I could say about them but in the short amount of time I spent in research, it gave me a high level of respect for those who guard the tomb. As I was thinking about this, the Moody statement above came to mind. I had to ask myself, what if I was that dedicated to following Christ? What could God do with my life? What would that even look like? Those are really tough questions to answer. When I think about that level of commitment, it really challenges me to evaluate my relationship with Christ. God's not asking me to be perfect, but I think He does expect me to continue to improve. I don't have to make big changes all at once. It can be one small step at a time.

Take time to pray and ask God to show you one thing that you can do to strengthen your relationship with Him?


