- Mentoring of men in the community and additional volunteers as the ministry grows.


1ST ANNUAL FAITH RUN

GENUINE CONCERN

19 I hope in the Lord Jesus to send Timothy to you soon, that I also may be cheered when I receive news about you. 20 I have no one else like him, who will show genuine concern for your welfare. 21 For everyone looks out for their own interests, not those of Jesus Christ. 22 But you know that Timothy has proved himself, because as a son with his father he has served with me in the work of the gospel. – Philippians 2:19–22

Every year I am amazed by the amount of money that professional athletes get for playing their sport. Just when you think the contracts can't go any higher, every year there is an athlete asking for more. Lamar Jackson, quarterback for the Baltimore Ravens is asking for 230 million for his next contract. Which is nothing to the over 300 million Arron Judge of the New York Yankees is expected to get for his next contract. My favorite contract of all time is Bobby Bonilla formerly of the New York Mets. He was done playing baseball in 2001 but still gets 1.9 million from the Mets every July 1st and will get that until 2035. Mets Fans call it "Bobby Bonilla Day"

When these players are negotiating their contracts, it's all about them and their ability and what they can do. I am not aware of a contract that had a stipulation in it that said if one of his teammates did something to help them succeed in their sport, they would get part of their money. It's not true of all athletes, and I am sure there are many that genuinely care for their teammates, but me first seems to be a pretty common attitude in professional sports.

In these verses in Philippians, I love how Paul describes Timothy. He says there is "no one else like him, who will show a genuine concern for your welfare". Timothy did not have a me first attitude. Timothy proved himself to be genuinely concerned for others. What an amazing thing to be said about you.

We can all think of someone that is genuinely concerned for others. It seems to come naturally to them, a gift from God.

What about you? Are you genuinely concerned about others? It may not come naturally to you, but it is something you can work on.
